Curriculum Highlights

In four-year-old preschool, the Splash into Pre-K curriculum supports every aspect of student development: physical, social, emotional, cognitive and linguistic. Children learn skills through playful, child-centered activities that ensure they maintain their love of learning.

Language Arts: Students will focus on pre-reading skills and will become aware of how sounds in words work. They will identify syllables, beginning sound, and rhymes. Children will also recognize and name upper and lowercase letters and develop an understanding and purpose of writing.

Math: Our program provides purposeful, engaging mathematical investigations and activities that build upon a child's understanding of patterns, numbers, measurement and shapes.

Religion: Students learn that God made all of us unique and special. Students learn appropriate Scripture stories and important people in the Bible that tells them of God's love and connects these stories to their own lives.
