Curriculum Highlights

In 4-Year-Old Preschool, the "Splash into Pre-K Curriculum" supports every aspect of student development: physical, social, emotional, cognitive and linguistic. Children learn skills through playful, child-centered activities that ensure a love of learning.

Language Arts: Students focus on pre-reading skills and become aware of sounds within words. They identify syllables, beginning word sounds, and rhymes. Children also learn to recognize and name upper and lowercase letters. Children begin to understand the purpose of writing.

Math: Our program provides purposeful, engaging mathematical investigations and activities that build upon a child's understanding of patterns, numbers, measurement and shapes.

Religion: Students learn that God has made all people unique and special. Age-appropriate Scripture stories introduce children to important Biblical figures who teach them of God's love in their own lives.

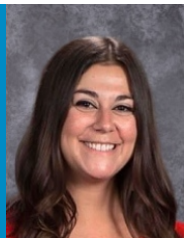
