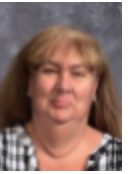

Curriculum Highlights

Language Arts: First grade is a pivotal age for putting sounds together and reading. Through daily reading, literacy centers, phonics and weekly spelling words using the Orton-Gillingham series, students become confident early readers.

Math: The math curriculum is designed to engage students in hands-on learning and mathematical discovery, which assists students with operations and algebraic thinking, number sense, measurement and data, and geometry.

Science: Students study topics such as life cycles and life stages, habitats, plants and trees, exploring sunlight, water and soil and insects.

Social Studies: Students learn about a broad array of topics such as maps, citizenship, past, present and future, different cultures, needs versus wants, rules, and goods and services.

Religion: First Graders study the liturgical seasons of the Church, the Blessed Trinity, the Sacraments, and Scripture. Students also learn prayers.



Students in Grades K-8 take the Measurement of Academic Performance (MAP) evaluations. Saint Rose School students score consistently higher than their peers in the Diocese of Toledo and across the United States.
