## Curriculum Highlights

Language Arts: Children become more independent readers covering a variety of genres of literature, including fiction and non-fiction. Third graders learn to read non-fiction text to gather information and then use that information to write paragraphs.

*Math:* Our math curriculum is designed to engage students in hands-on learning and mathematical discovery. Some topics of study are multiplication, division, perimeter and area.

*Science*: Rocks, soil, matter, animals and plants are all studied in third grade. Children are engaged in hands-on, real world discoveries.

Social Studies: Map skills, government, and economics are a few of the topics in third grade. Students also learn about their cultural background and study the history of Perrysburg.

**Religion**: Students learn about the 12 apostles, liturgical year, and parts of the Mass. They also learn The Apostle's Creed.
