Teacher Highlights

Mrs. Areddy holds a Master of Education degree in Elementary Education from The University of Toledo, and has a Reading Endorsement Certification. She has taught for 16 years, and joined the Saint Rose School team in 2013. She teaches 4th and 5th grade science.

Mrs. Dubois, a Saint Rose School alumnae, holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Middle Childhood Education from Bowling Green State University. She has taught in the Diocese of Toledo for 11 years, and has been a teacher at Saint Rose School since 2014. Mrs. Dubois teaches 4th grade social studies.

Mrs. Henry graduated with her Bachelor of Arts degree in Education from Notre Dame College and has advanced Catechist Certification. She has taught within the Diocese of Toledo for over 35 years and has served the students at Saint Rose for 18 years. Mrs. Henry teaches 5th grade math, language arts, and religion.

Curriculum Highlights

Language Arts: Students read a wide variety of materials in order to sharpen their fluency and comprehension. In addition to the Accelerated Reader program, the class reads a novel together and study literary elements. The curriculum also includes developing detailed and organized writing techniques. Children work on expanding vocabulary in order to enhance the writing process.

Math: In fifth grade, instructional time focuses on developing fluency with fractions, understanding whole numbers and decimal operations, as well as the concepts of volume and measurement.

Science: This hands-on course teaches students about cycles and patterns in the solar system, interconnections within ecosystems, and how force and mass affect the motion of an object. The fifth grade students participate in the DARE program and visit the Challenger Space Center.

Social Studies: Fifth graders will expand their knowledge of American History by studying explorers, Native Americans and the westward expansion. Fifth graders also participate in the National Geography Bee.



Students in grades k-8 take the Measurement of Academic Performance (MAP) evaluations. Saint Rose School students scored higher than the national and diocesan averages in all subject areas.
