Curriculum Highlights

Language Arts: Students are offered a variety of reading experiences. There is a focus on written expression, including expository, narrative, and persuasive writing. Students also work on grammar and usage skills.

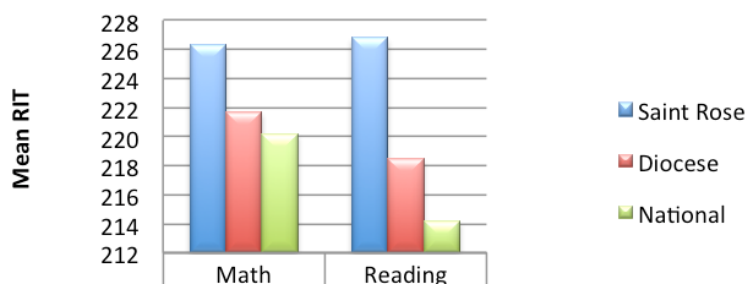
Math: 7th Grade Mathematics includes Geometry, Measurement, Integer Operations, and Algebra. Our Accelerated 7th Grade Mathematics class provides students a combined 7th/8th Grade curriculum, and we also offer a high school level class for our highly motivated students.

Science: This course engages students in project-based learning, while studying the cycles and conservation of matter and energy, as well as cycles and patterns of the earth and moon.

Social Studies: Beginning with ancient Greece and Rome and then following major historical development, the 7th Grade curriculum highlights themes including increased globalization, the roots of American democracy, and economic reasons for exploration.

Religion: The 7th Grade curriculum examines the New Testament in depth, working with all four gospels to study Jesus' mission and analyze His words. This course explores the Acts of the Apostles and inspects the formative days of the Catholic Church through the trials of St. Paul.
