Curriculum Highlights

Language Arts: Students are exposed to literature in varied genres. Students further develop critical reading and analysis skills. There is a focus on written expression, including expository, narrative, and argumentative writing. Students also work on grammar and usage skills.

Math: 7th Grade Mathematics includes Geometry, Measurement, Integer Operations, and Algebra. The Accelerated 7th Grade Mathematics class provides students a combined 7th/8th Grade curriculum and offers a high school level class for highly motivated students.


Science: This course engages students in hands-on activities, while studying the cycles and conservation of matter and energy, as well as cycles and patterns of the earth and moon.

Social Studies: Beginning with ancient Greece and Rome and then following major historical development, the 7th Grade curriculum highlights themes including increased globalization, the roots of American democracy, and economic reasons for exploration.

Religion: The 7th Grade curriculum examines the New Testament in depth, working with all four gospels to study Jesus' mission and analyze His words. This course explores the Acts of the Apostles and inspects the formative days of the Catholic Church through the trials of St. Paul.

Mrs. Sankowski earned a Bachelor's of Education degree in English and Music from the University of Toledo. She has been teaching in the Diocese of Toledo for over 20 years. She has been at Saint Rose since 2016. She teaches seventh and eighth grade language arts and literature in addition to her role as assistant principal at Saint Rose.
