Mission Anchored in the Catholic faith and academic excellence, Saint Rose Catholic School is a faith-based community rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ. Our school strives to instill moral virtues to form effective servant-leaders in the world. Students are taught to nurture their gifts from God, build a compassionate community, and bring about His Kingdom on earth.

Faculty Saint Rose School has 56 teachers, aides, educational support specialists, and administrative members who hold 27 Bachelor degrees, 17 Master degrees, and one Doctoral degree. The average class size is 23 students in K-8. Preschool, depending on the grade level, maintains at most a 1:12 teacher/student ratio.

Governor's Award Saint Rose school has received the Governor's Thomas Edison Award for Excellence in STEM Education and Student Research for four years: 2020-2021, 2021-2022, 2022-2023, and 2024-2025 school years.

Curriculum The curriculum is based upon the course of study issued by the Superintendent of Catholic Schools for the Diocese of Toledo. The math program allows students to use real-world, hands-on examples to investigate and learn concepts, rather than memorize facts. This approach accelerates students' learning, allowing middle school students to take a high-school level class. Advanced English/Language Arts classes are available as well. Religion is taught in every grade. Instruction in computer, art, music and library skills begins in Kindergarten Readiness. Spanish classes begin in Third Grade. These classes are an integral part of the curriculum through Eighth Grade in addition to the traditional subjects. One-to-one iPad usage begins in Sixth Grade.






Twice annually, Saint Rose School administers the Measure of Academic Performance (MAP) standardized assessment to track academic progress, both individually and as grade levels.


Fall 2025 NWEA MAP Reading Scores
