Mission As a Catholic, faith-based community, Saint Rose School provides challenging academics and spiritual development in a safe and supportive environment. Students are nurtured to be confident life-long learners and disciples of Christ, prepared for future endeavors and service to society.

Faculty Saint Rose School has 43 faculty and administrative members who hold 16 Bachelor degrees, 17 Master degrees, and one Doctoral degree. The average class size is 20 students in K-8. Preschool, depending on the grade level, maintains at most a 1:12 teacher/student ratio.

Governor's Award Saint Rose school has received the Governor's Thomas Edison Award for Excellence in STEM Education and Student Research for two years in a row, both the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school.

Curriculum The curriculum is based upon the course of study issued by the Superintendent of Catholic Schools for the Diocese of Toledo. The math program allows students to use real-world, hands-on examples to investigate and learn concepts, rather than memorize facts. This approach accelerates students' learning, allowing middle school students to take a high-school level class. Advanced English/Language Arts classes are available as well. Religion is taught in every grade. Instruction in computer, art, music and library skills begins in Kindergarten Readiness. Spanish classes begin in Third Grade. These classes are an integral part of the curriculum through Eighth Grade in addition to the traditional subjects. One-to-one iPad usage begins in Sixth Grade.

Extracurricular

Extended Day Program: The Extended Day program is available from 7:00-8:45 AM and 3:30-6:00 PM on regularly scheduled school days. Fun activities and homework help are available for all age groups.

CYO Sports: The Catholic Youth Organization offers football, basketball, softball, soccer, volleyball, cheerleading, cross- country and track & field.

Tutoring: Saint Rose School offers after school tutoring with our intervention specialists. This is open to all of our students in grades 4-8.

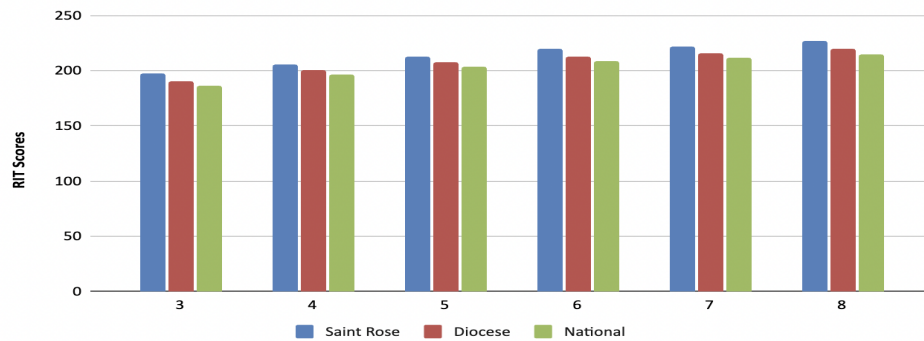
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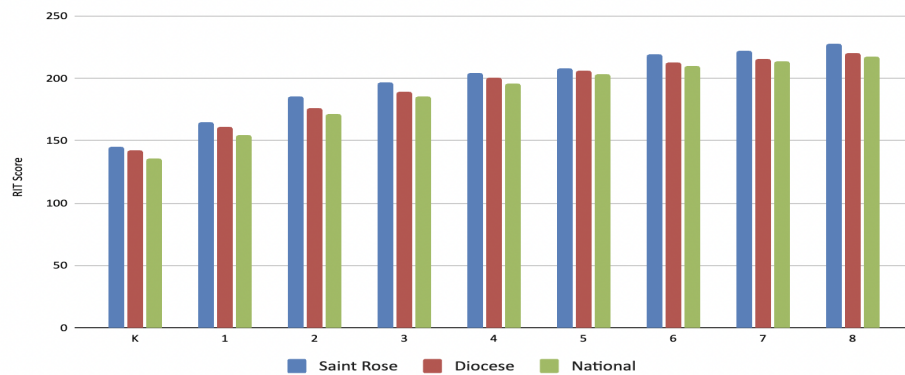


Twice annually, Saint Rose School administers the Measure of Academic Performance (MAP) standardized assessment to track academic progress, both individually and as grade levels.

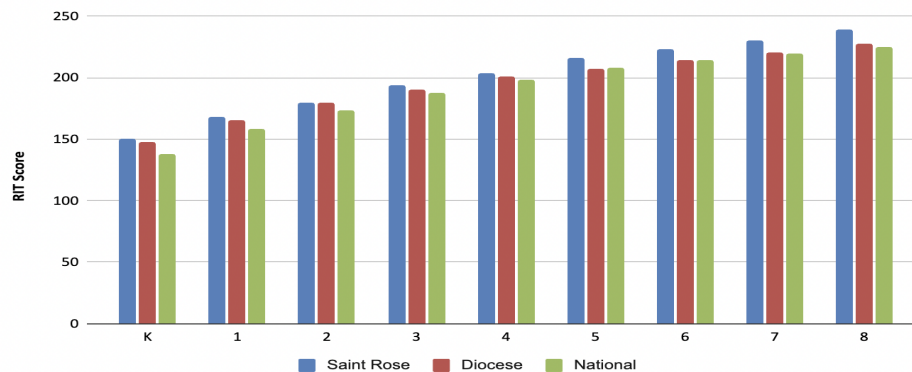
Mean Language RIT Scores
